

### What Man Must Do

Man must be born again to receive eternal life by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone. (Acts 16:31, Romans 4:5, Ephesians 2:8-9)

### The World's Salvation

- Salvation comes to those who do more good than bad.
- Salvation comes as long as we are tolerant and loving of everyone.
- Salvation comes from being yourself and the most you, you can be.
- Salvation comes from any source as long as we are genuine.
- There is no salvation, only nothingness.

### Christian Salvation

- There is a such thing as eternal life and it can be found.
- Salvation is eternal life.
- Man must be born again and be a new creation.
- The Holy Spirit must regenerate us.
- This new life is something only Jesus provides.
- We are dead in sin and cannot fix ourselves or make ourselves new.
- "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God." - John 3:3
- "He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and the renewal of the Holy Spirit." - Titus 3:5

### Grace Alone

- New life can only be found through grace.
- Grace is the unmerited, undeserved favor of God.
- Salvation is not something we are owed.
- Salvation is not something God must provide in order to be fair.
- Salvation is not something that we can earn.
- Our sin deserves eternal death.
- This grace must be received and accepted.
- "And are justified by grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus." - Romans 3:24
- "By grace you have been saved through faith." -Eph 2:8

### Faith Alone

- We receive this grace of salvation only through faith in Jesus.
- Our faith does not have to be perfect or understand every subtlety of Christianity.
- Faith is more than just an intellectual assent to facts.

- We cannot earn salvation through works.
- However, our faith is revealed through our works.
- Righteous works are the outward expression of inward faith.
- "What must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." - Acts 16:31-32
- "And this is not your own doing: it is the gift of God Not the result of works, so that no one may boast." - Eph 2:8-9

#### Christ Alone

- There is no other god who provides salvation.
- There are no other paths or options.
- There is no saint or holy person who can provide it.
- Jesus is the only way to the Father.
- "Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." - John 14:6
- "And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." Acts 4:12

#### Essential

- This is the gospel and the core part of Christianity.
- You cannot divorce the gospel from the other essentials of the faith.
- Remember what good news the gospel is.
